Quick Facts about Suratul-Insaan

Suratul-Insaan was revealed in **Makkah**, before the Hijrah* to Madinah.

Rasulullah簿 used to recite Suratul-Insaan (along with Surtatus-Sajdah) in Fajr prayer on Fridays.

Suratul-Insaan is so special because...

Suratul-Insaan tells us so much about what **Jannah** is like, and what we need to do to get there!

Suratul-Insaan is all about...

How Allah has given us two choices, with two different rewards...

Listen to Allah and go to Jannah, or Don't listen to Allah and go to Jahannam.

*Hijrab is the journey Rasulullah (and all those who followed him) made to Madinah after teaching Islam in Makkah for many years and being rejected by his people. After the Hijrah Rasunllah established the Islamic State in Madinah and eventually terturned to peacefully conquer Makshah.

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Now let's learn what Suratul-Insaan says...

In the name of Allah, the Beneficent, the Merciful.



We start Suratul-Insaan by remembering Allah.

Has there not been over Man a long period of Time, when he was nothing - (not even) mentioned?

هَلْ أَتَى عَلَى الْإِنسَلْنِ حِينٌ مِّنَ اللهِ اللهُ اللهُ

Verily We created Man from a drop of mingled sperm, in order to try him: So We gave him (the gifts), of Hearing and Sight.

إِنَّا خَلَقْنَا الْإِنسَلِنَ مِن نُطْفَةٍ أَمْشَاجٍ لَنَّا خَلَقْنَا الْإِنسَلِنَ مِن نُطْفَةٍ أَمْشَاجٍ لَنَّالِيهِ فَجَعَلْنَلُهُ سَمِيعًا بَصِيرًا

We showed him the Way: whether he be grateful or ungrateful (rests on his will).

إِنَّا هَدَيْنَاهُ السَّبِيلَ إِمَّا شَاكِرًا وَ إِمَّا كُورًا

Allah tells us...

He is the one who created us out of a little bit of liquid.

Then He made us grow by stages into human beings.

Allah created us so that He could test us to see who will be good or not.

Allah has given us eyes to see, and ears to hear.

Allah has shown us the right way to live, by sending prophets and books.

Allah has given "Al-Insaan" (humans) two choices...

- We can be grateful for Allah's blessings, by being good, or
- 2. We can be ungrateful for Allah's blessing, by **being bad**.

For the Rejecters we have prepared chains, yokes, and a blazing Fire.

إِنَّا أَعْتَدْنَا لِلْكَلْفِرِينَ سَلَسلاً وَأَغْلَلاً وَسَعِيرًا

As to the Righteous, they shall drink of a Cup (of Wine) mixed with Kafur,-

إِنَّ ٱلْأَبْرَارَ يَشْرَبُونَ مِن كَأْسٍ كَأْسٍ كَأْسٍ كَانَ مِزَاجُهَا كَافُورًا

A Fountain where the Devotees of Allah do drink, making it flow in unstinted abundance.

عَيْنًا يَشْرَبُ بِهَا عِبَادُ اللَّهِ يُفَجِّرُونَهَا تَفْجيرًا Allah has given us two choices and Allah has given two rewards...

The reward of the ungrateful people (who do not listen to Allah) is...

CHAIRS Yokes (collars),

and the fire of Jahannam.

The reward of the grateful people (who listened to Allah) is....

a ${\it CUD}$ that will be filled with ${\it cool drinks}$ from the

fountains of Jannah. Only the best people who loved Allah will drink from these fountains.



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
