Teaching TIP: When using the CD to practice each surah, you may also want to use the Mini Tafseer Book for the surah so that your child can follow along with each ayah as it is recited, and associate it with the Tafseer lesson. This method can be particularly effective in these lessons, where the suwaar are longer, and you want to make listening more fun!

Discussion:

This surah can be used to reinforce discipline with your child. The surah talks about cheating and this can be expanded to any type of trickery, lying, deceit, etc. Since children often get in to trouble for doing things that fall into this category, you can use this surah to teach your child that Allahﷻ does not love this behavior.

Many of the suwaar in the Qur'aan can be used to reinforce discipline. Remember it is very easy for a child to think he can fool you, but most children will think harder about their actions if you say that Allahﷻ does not like it. In the end, we want children to listen to Allahﷻ first and foremost, so we should always use these opportunities to reinforce obedience to Allahﷻ and using the Qur'aan as a guide for our lives if we want to be successful.

Discussion:

All of the ad'iyaa that you will study in this unit are related to being tested with hardships. These ad'iyaa show us the words to use in these situations. It is of great importance that children realize these ad'iyaa are not just nice to say, they actually help us get through difficult times by remembering Allahﷻ.

For this lesson, we will concentrate on a dua that is usually said when someone dies or when we have a major loss in our lives. It is at these times that we need to remember Allahﷻ, and Allahﷻ has taught us the words to do this properly, Al-hamdulillah.

This dua is also quite short, so if your child needs to review any ad'iyaa from the previous units, now would be a good time to do that.

Activities: Story Time!



1. Take this opportunity to do a little creative writing with your child. Since the topic is dealing with loss, and what to say, maybe your child would enjoy writing a short story to illustrate the point. For example, you can help him write a short story about a time when someone would need to make the dua for loss, or a time in his life when saying the dua for loss would have (or did) help him feel better.
2. When your finished have you child make an illustration to go with the story. Remember not to allow pictures of humans and/or animals, rather concentrate on the place where the story takes place or items mentioned in the story.

Discussion:

In this lesson, we will focus on how Allah ﷻ prevails over His creation. This may be a difficult concept for your child to understand at first. He may think that prevailing means that Allah ﷻ takes over the creation and we do not have any free choice. This is not the case. Allah ﷻ lets us choose what we will do, but in the end, His plan prevails. This is a subtle difference in meaning linguistically, but applied to the creation, the difference is like night and day.

Note: Keep in mind that this new volume of the Khadijah & Khaalid stories begins seven years later, after the children have grown up. Khadijah is about to get married and Khaalid is in Dental School, while Abdul-Khaaliq and Abdul-Haseeb are now in middle school.



Activities: Discussion and Coloring Time

In this lesson, you will introduce Futhatayn (two Futha's). Surprisingly, most children pick up Futhatayn (and all the other double vowels) quite easily. The main focus of the lesson should be identification, correct pronunciation, writing, and reviewing all the other Tashkeel studied so far.

Activities: Tipping the Scales!



Since this surah talks about cheating, now would be a good time to tie in your science lessons with a talk about weights and measures. When weighing and measuring items for sale many people cheat by giving less than they should. This was the main thing that the people of Shu'aib were punished for. You can illustrate the point by using a scale to measure food items and showing how a person might keep their hand on the scale (pressing down) to make it appear that they are giving more of the product, but in fact, it is less than what is supposed to be on the scale. Then show your child how weighing the correct amount is done (no pressing down on the scale).

Discussion:

In this lesson, you will focus on the dua for difficulty. This dua is usually said when something happens to a person that they do not like, but for which they are trying to be patient. This dua puts the believer in the right state of mind from the very beginning. By recognizing that Allahﷻ is in control and He is the only one who can relieve us of our difficulty, we begin the process of coping and seeking Allah's mercy.

Note: It is relevant to mention at this point that a Muslim should never pray for patience or strength. Rasulullahﷺ told us that doing so would lead to us being tested with even more hardships than before. Rather we should ask Allahﷻ to relieve us from the hardship and to grant us good in this life and the next.

Discussion: Seek Understanding with the Help of the Scholars

If you come across anything in the tafseer that is not clear to you, or that you are unfamiliar with, be cautious in offering explanations to your child. Make sure that your understanding is supported by the Qur'aan itself, ahadith, or the interpretation of the Mufasssireen (scholars of exegesis of the Qur'aan). It is common for people in our generation to seek understandings in the Qur'aan that may not have foundations in authentic sources. Therefore, it is best to start with the authentic sources (as we do in the curriculum, i.e. Ibn Kathir, Bukhari, Muslim, etc.) and let that understanding guide you and your child.

Saying this dua is easy on the tongue, but hard for the heart. In order to make our heart accept Allah's decision we must be humble, admit that we are weak and acknowledge that we need Allah's help.

Since the topic is accepting Allah's decision in a matter, and what to say, maybe your child would enjoy writing a short story to illustrate the point. For example, you can help him write a short story about a time when someone would need to accept Allah's decision (i.e. losing a job, losing money, not getting something you wanted, etc.).
2. When your finished have you child make an illustration to go with the story. Remember not to allow pictures of humans and/or animals, rather concentrate on the place where the story takes place or items mentioned in the story.

2. Discuss any ideas or vocabulary that your child does not understand.
3. Try to make the concepts taught in these lessons more concrete by identifying times in your life where you have experienced this specific attribute of Allah ﷻ, and sharing these stories with your child.

Lesson Warm-Up

- __ Practice Suratul-Mootufeeeen and review its tafseer using Mini Tafseer Book #33.
- __ Practice the recitation and meaning of the dua for acceptance.
- __ Review Lesson 34 & 35 from Khadijah & Khaalid and discuss the main points.
- __ Play with the Qur'aan & Arabic Teacher CD (all sections) for 15-20 minutes as review and to get a head start on the material to be covered in coming lessons.

Assignment: Lesson 23: Kusratayn from "Arabic Exercise Book III"

Carry out the following steps:

1. Use Arabic Exercise Book III to complete the lesson assignment. Try to complete a section every day so that your child has daily Arabic lessons.
2. Apply Arabic skills in other subject areas whenever possible. For example when reading the names of Allah ﷻ or reading the vocabulary from the Qur'aan lesson, look for the letters being studied.
3. **Pacing:** You should plan to cover 1-2 pages every day.

Discussion:

In this lesson, you will introduce Kusratayn. Like Futhatayn, most students have little trouble understanding this sign. However, your child may confuse Futhatayn and Kusratayn when reading them in the Qur'aan. This may be a good time to review the memory hints used in previous lessons for Futha and Kusra, and emphasize that these hints can help you identify Futhatayn and Kusratayn as well.
