

## Quick Facts about Suratul-Mooduthir

Suratul-Mooduthir was revealed in **Makkah**,  
before the Hijrah\* to Madinah.

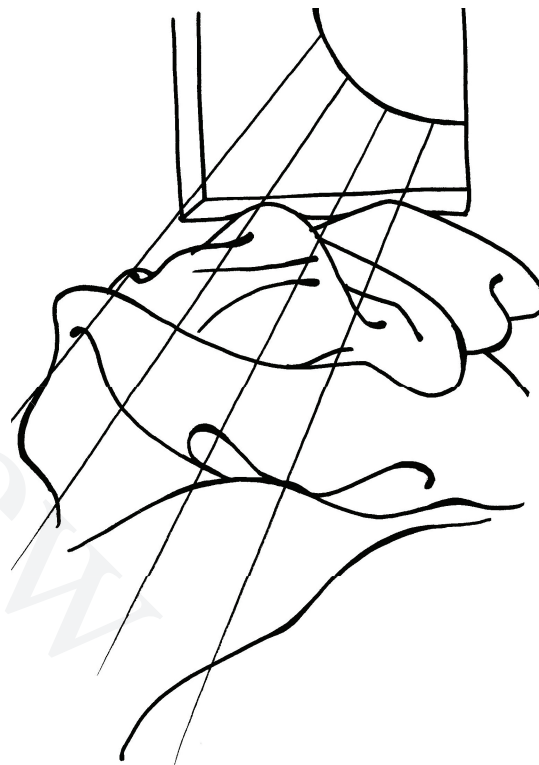
Suratul-Mooduthir is the **second revelation** the  
Rasulullah ﷺ received from Angel Gibreel.

Suratul-Mooduthir tells us what the people of Jannah  
and the people of Jahannam will **say to each other**.

Suratul-Mooduthir tells us how many **angels** are in  
charge of **Jahannam**.

Suratul-Mooduthir is all about how  
Allah told Rasulullah ﷺ to teach  
Islaam, and what people say when  
they hear his message.

\*Hijrah is the journey Rasulullah ﷺ (and all those who followed him) made to Madinah after teaching Islaam in  
Makkah for many years and being rejected by his people. After the Hijrah Rasulullah ﷺ established the Islamic State in  
Madinah and eventually returned to peacefully conquer Makkah.

## We start Suratul-Mooduthir by remembering Allah

You have learned the story of how Rasulallah ﷺ received the first verses from Angel Gibreel in **Ghar Hira** (Hira Cave), when you studied Suratul-Alaq.

Now you will learn the story of the second set of verses that Rasulallah ﷺ received.

## This is how the story goes...

There was a man named...

**Al-Waleed bin Al-Moogheerah Al-Mukhzoomee**

(Al-Wa-leed bin Al-Moo-ghee-rah Al-Mukh-zoo-mee)

Al-Waleed had heard that Rasulallah ﷺ had gotten a message from Angel Gibreel (Suratul-'Alaq), so he decided to have party with the leaders of Quraysh and see what everyone had to say about it.

Some people said Rasulallah ﷺ was **crazy**, some said he was a **magician** and some said that Rasulallah ﷺ was just doing **tricks** that he learned from people that lived a long time ago.

It had been a while since Angel Gibreel had come to Rasulallah ﷺ in the cave. Rasulallah ﷺ was worried that maybe he was crazy, and maybe what the people said about him was true.

Then soon after that, Rasulallah ﷺ was walking in Makkah, and he heard a voice calling him. He looked up at the sky and saw **Angel Gibreel** sitting in a chair between the Earth and the sky.

Rasulallah ﷺ was a very brave man, he was usually not afraid of things, but Angel Gibreel was so **HUGE** that Rasulallah ﷺ felt afraid of him.

Rasulallah ﷺ rushed back home, and when he got there, he told his wife Khadijah to cover him up with a blanket or cloth...

**It was during this meeting with Angel Gibreel that Allah revealed the beginning of Suratul-Mooduthir to Rasulallah ﷺ**

Oh thou wrapped up (in the mantle)!

يَا أَيُّهَا الْمُدَّثِّرُ

Arise and warn!

قُمْ فَأَنْذِرْ

And thy Lord do thou magnify!

وَرَبَّكَ فَكَبِّرْ

And thy garments keep free from stain!

وَتِيَابَكَ فَطَهِّرْ

And all abomination shun!

وَالرُّجْزَ فَاهْجُرْ

Nor expect, in giving, any increase (for thyself)!

وَلَا تَمُنْ بِتَسْكِينِ

But, for thy Lord's (Cause), be patient and constant!

وَلِرَبِّكَ فَاصْبِرْ

When Allah gave Rasulullah ﷺ Suratul-Mooduthir, He wanted to teach Rasulullah ﷺ certain things that he needed to do in order to be a prophet and to teach people about Islam.

So Allah told Rasulullah ﷺ 6 things that he must do...

1. Go out and warn people that Yawmul-Qiyaamah is coming.
2. Praise Allah.
3. Make sure your money and clothes are clean and pure (there is nothing haraam in them).
4. Stay away from any bad thing, like the idols the Quraysh used to worship.
5. Do not give up doing good, just in order to get something you like.
6. Don't get tired, keep working for the sake of Allah.

Finally, when the Trumpet is sounded,

فَإِذَا نُقِرَ فِي النَّاقُورِ

That will be- that Day - a Day of Distress,-

فَذَٰلِكَ يَوْمٌ عَسِيرٌ

Far from easy for those without Faith.

عَلَى الْكَافِرِينَ غَيْرُ يَسِيرٍ

## Rasulullah ﷺ was sent to warn people about Yowmul-Qiyaamah...

So Rasulullah ﷺ did what Allah told him to do. He started telling the people of Makkah about the things that Allah had taught him in Suratul-Mooduthir. Here are the things that he said...

Yowmul-Qiyaamah will start suddenly when the **trumpet** is blown. The trumpet will make a very **LOUD** noise.

The trumpet will be blown by an angel named **Israfeel**. Rasulullah ﷺ told us that Israfeel is already waiting with his mouth on the trumpet, ready to blow it the moment that Allah tells him to.

When he blows the trumpet everyone will know that Yowmul-Qiyaamah has started.

Yowmul-Qiyaamah will not be an easy day because of all the things that will happen...

**Especially for the people who  
said that it would not happen!**

Leave Me alone, (to deal) with the (creature) whom I created (bare and) alone!-

ذَرْنِي وَمَنْ خَلَقْتُ وَحِيدًا

To whom I granted resources in abundance,

وَجَعَلْتُ لَهُ مَالًا مَمْدُودًا

And sons to be by his side!-

وَبَنِينَ شُهُودًا

To whom I made (life) smooth and comfortable!

وَمَهَّدْتُ لَهُ تَمْهِيدًا

Yet is he greedy-that I should add (yet more):-

ثُمَّ يَطْمَعُ أَنْ أَزِيدَ

On Yowmul-Qjyaamah Allah will  
take care of each person  
according to what they did...

Allah will reward the good people for what they did,  
and will punish the bad people for what they did as  
well.

Allah is the one who created us the first time as a  
baby. We were nothing and Allah made us grow...

He gave us money...

He gave us children...

He made things easy for us...

Yet some people do not thank Allah  
or do what Allah says!

All they want is for Allah to keep  
giving them more!
